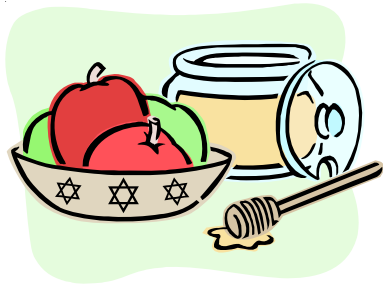

Building On The Past: The Beth Sholom High Holy Day Experience

As our new spiritual leader, Rabbi Murray Singerman has assumed the pulpit of Beth Sholom Congregation. With the assistance of the Religious Affairs Committee, he has formulated a plan for High Holy Day services which will build on our traditional customs. Our goal is to experience these days of beauty in a meaningful, spiritual manner.



- * We will use the Silverman Machzor, which will be available in the foyer as you enter the building.
- * Led by Morrie Kelsey, the Musaf (Additional) service will be sung to customary Beth Sholom melodies. Rabbi Singerman will lead the Shacharit (Morning) services with a mixture of traditional and Chassidic melodies.
- * We will follow the universal custom of congregants reciting prayers along with the Chazan.
- * The Torah will be read with the traditional High Holy Day cantillation.
- * Women will be called to the Torah for Aliyot and given other honors.
- * We will try to include as many congregants as possible when distributing honors. If you would like a non-aliyah honor, such as opening the ark, please let the Religious Affairs Committee know by leaving a message with Pauline or Janet. ☆

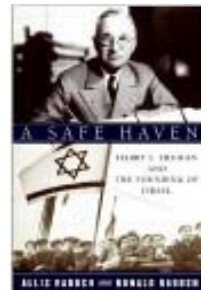
Beth Sholom Program Committee

**A FAITH IN THE FUTURE
A BELIEF IN ACTION**

Thank you to all who responded to our internet survey. The responses were helpful and the Board will be considering them closely as we plan our activities for the next year. The following summarizes some of the responses:

Meetings: About 30% of those that responded indicated that our meetings are not held at a convenient time and the majority suggested a preference for meeting one evening during the week. Starting in September, NCJW Frederick Section will be meeting the first Tuesday of every month at 7 p.m.

Programs: Respondents provided good feedback regarding the types of programs they would like to see offered. Community Service programs ranked high on the list as well as coed programs that are centered around Jewish life or are entertaining (but don't require active audience participation).

Collections: Although responses indicate that the collections we did this past year for COIP, the Cold Weather Shelter, Kline Hospice House and Adopt a Family should be repeated, we also received some recommendations for other collections to consider. As a result, we will be collecting for the Frederick Animal Control Division and Shelter in September and early October. Please keep an eye out for details.

Activities: When asked about our specific activities, most respondents indicated that they did not participate in the activities but that they thought we should repeat them again this year. The Board will look at this area closely to see what we can do to encourage greater participation.

Communications: It appears that we provide the right level of communication. However, it is disappointing that most respondents indicated that they have never checked out the NCJW Frederick Section Web site. We do try to keep this site current so please take the time to check it out periodically [www.ncjwfrederick.org]. And no, you won't be seeing us on Facebook any time soon.

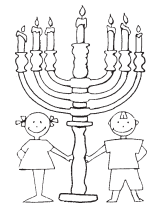
Demographics: The Board will be focusing on how to attract younger members. If you have ideas, please let us know!

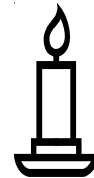
